VISION & DECLARATION

Adopted: October 24, 2009

1.0 Vision Statement

The Vision Statement of the N'Quatqua First Nation:

“We will honour and respect our lands and resources through a holistic approach. We will be committed to a strong, loving, healthy and sustainable community that will have a consistent approach to education, culture and language. A self governance system that will allow us to grow and meet our needs.”

1.1 Mission Statement

The Mission Statement of the N'Quatqua First Nation:

“We promote and encourage families to create and maintain a healthy community. We support the development of self-governance while respecting our relationship with the land, culture and language.”

1.2 Values

The Values as defined by the N'Quatqua First Nation to accompany the Vision and Mission Statements include the following core values:

- To reflect the N'Quatqua culture, values and traditions
- To honour our land and resources
- To incorporate a process for feedback, evaluation, accountability and reporting
- To provide the opportunity for all community members to participate
- To promote an open and inclusive governance and administrative system
- To promote respect for oneself and respect for others

1.3 N'quatqua Declaration

We affirm our original identity as N'Quatqua people.

In our relationship, we are part of the St'atl'imx Nation through language, blood ties to St'atl'imx in other villages, political, spiritual, economic, traditional, cultural, social and historical ties.

We affirm our Declaration of the Lillooet Tribes of May 10th, 1911 signed by our forefathers in declaring our rights and title.
